Cedar,

Thank you for the information. I do not think a permit from the District is needed for your research and sampling activities if there will be no proposed construction of structures (temporary/permanent) or wetland/other surface water resource impacts (dredge/fill). For example, if you needed to construct a dock or sampling platform in the river, this would likely need a permit and a separate sovereign submerged lands authorization from the Division of State Lands. However, it appears what you are proposing will have no impacts and a permit would not be required.
